In reference to the Covid 19 virus. our facility will be following protocols set in place by the CDC and Bright from the Start.

- Temperature screenings will be performed on students and staff upon entering the building.

SECURITY UPDATES禁

We have been working diligently to create a safer environment in our school building. We have recently added more security cameras to our campus as well as improving lock down features. We will have a key fob system installed on our front door for parental access during school hours. The front doors will be unlocked from 7:30-8am and 2:45-3:15pm for pick up. If you need to pick up your child outside of these hours you will need to use your family assigned key fob or ring door bell for assistance.

PICK UP/DROP OFF CHANGES

This year we have revamped how school aged children will be picked-up and dropped-off. We will now have a "Car-rider" lane that will flow from Highway 57 between the Wilkinson County Heath Department and Senior Center, stop at the awning connected to the HHCA playground for drop off and flow out onto East Main Street. For drop off, a staff member will meet your child at the awning and virtually check them in, then escort them into the building. For pick up your child will be escorted from the building to your car at the same awning. Car Rider Drop off and Pick up times will be from 7:30-8am and 2:45-3:15pm.
